

FISHING REGULATIONS FOR HERITAGE LAKE

CATCH AND RELEASE APPLY FOR THE FOLLOWING FISH.

**REDEAR SUNFISH UNTIL THE FY 2012 FISHING SEASON.
(SEE NOTE BELOW)**

**LARGE MOUTH BASS SLOT LIMIT, RELEASE BASS BETWEEN 14
AND 16 INCHES LONG.**

**KEEP LIMIT IS 6 BASS BETWEEN 10 AND 14 INCHES, OR 5 KEEPER
SIZE BASS PLUS ONE BASS OVER 16 INCHES.**

**NORTHERN PIKE AND TIGER MUSKIE, LIMIT IS 1 PER DAY, OVER
40 INCHES.**

WALLEYE, 16 INCHES, 3 PER DAY

CHANNEL CATFISH, ANY SIZE, 10 PER DAY

**NO LIMITS ON SIZE OR CATCH PER DAY FOR CRAPPIE,
SUNFISH, BULLHEAD, WHITE BASS AND STRIPED BASS**

**NOTE: REDEAR SUNFISH ARE SOMETIMES CALLED
“SHELL CRACKERS”. THE PRIME FOOD FOR THESE
FISH ARE SNAILS. SNAILS ARE THE PRIME
CARRIER OF THE DUCK MITE. THE RED EARED
SUNFISH WERE RECOMMENDED FOR “DUCK MITE”
CONTROL BY THE ILLINOIS DNR.**
