• Road Committee

- With the SSA officially passed, the Road committee's priority is to maintain the roads between now and then.
- o The desire is to move forward with the seal coating as prescribed in the proposed play.
- o A1 seal coat cannot be done until July /August, but quotes and bids can be gotten now.
- o Road fund is currently 116k.
- o Proposing to reseal the primary roads that need it. Kenton, backside of Heritage from boat ramp to Brandy, small section of Wilshire Wood. Estimated to cost approx. 91K
- Will get another influx of the 2016 Road Fund in July/August.
- Also need ditch work on Kenton. Approx. \$7,000
- Also includes spray patching. \$5,000
- o Temporary Repairs to major issues on primary roads are being discussed.
- o Committee is Shawn, Brad, Bob Pirtle, Bob Porter, and Marvin.
- Secondary Roads that need resurfacing is approximately the same, approx 92K.
- Working from the RIC plan to prevent further damage.
- o Believe that we should hit the primary roads first, mitigate the biggest risk first.

- Need to also budget for SSA engineering. Estimates are approximately 186k, but those are only an estimate. Resurfacing the secondary roads will take a backseat to SSA costs.

Treasurer's Report March 15, 2016

All data presented is as of February 29, 2016.

The Total Cash Balance is \$625,196.89 and is made up of the following fund balances:

General Fund\$144,044.28 Lake Fund\$88,387.13 Road Fund\$116,665.26 Emergency Fund\$75,171.01 Lake Fund CD\$100,480.49 General Fund CD\$50,386.77 General Fund CD2 ...\$50,061.95

The outstanding receivables total is \$279,397.35 an increase of \$144,802.05. 2016 General Assessments were due March 1 and account for \$155,766.64. For additional breakdown, please refer to the attached Balance Sheet.

The Year-to-date Net Income is 217,920.81 with Revenues of \$249,897.88 and Expenses of \$31,977.07. Please see the attach Profit and Loss Statement for further detail.

There were no unusual expenses or income in February.

As for actual Cash details, for the month of February the cash deposits were \$97,619.27 and the cash expenditures were \$9,279.76. Additional report details are posted on the Heritage Lake website.
