HERITAGE LAKE DOG PARK RULES

HOURS: OPEN DAWN TO DUSK

THE DOG PARK IS AVAILABLE FOR HERITAGE LAKE OWNERS & THEIR GUESTS

- 1) The dog owner agrees to assume the full risk of any injuries, damages or loss associated with their use of the Dog Park.
- 2) A handler age 16 or older, must be present at all times & is solely responsible for the actions of their dog(s).
- 3) Children must be at least 6 years of age & accompanied by a parent or guardian. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to supervise their children at all times to prevent accidents.
- 4) Dogs must be leashed while entering & exiting the dog park. Handler must have a leash in their possession at all times. Dog owners must remain with their dogs in the exercise area & must keep their dog in sight at all times.
- 5) Always open & close the dog park gates carefully. Call your dog away from the gate while others are entering or leaving.
- 6) Dogs showing aggression towards people or other dogs must be immediately leashed & removed from the dog park.
- 7) Excessive barking is strongly discouraged.
- 8) Dogs must have current vaccinations & wear up-to-date County rabies vaccination tags at all times. Puppies must have all vaccinations before entering. Owner information tags are also recommended.
- 9) Dogs in heat are not allowed in the dog park.
- 10) Owner must clean up & dispose of feces left by their dog. Plastic baggies & garbage cans are available on the premises. Failing to clean up after animals will result in loss of privileges to use the park.
- 11) Food, treats & rawhide are not allowed in the dog park.
- 12) Infraction of any of these rules can result in temporary or permanent loss of park privileges.
