Conservation

- Prioritized the budget, dam repair items are the highest priority. We have budgeted 70,000 for a tube liner and 5,000 for a fix on the base scour hole
- Have decided to hire and use an engineer to advise us on and do the work for us. Mike Bryant, the same one that does our inspections.
- Asked what the status of the Lake fund CD is
 - Bonnie has a date, it is about 30 days before you said you needed it.
- Everything that we do will be about \$110,000 in total so we will work with the treasurer to get that available.
- Blake Reubush filed a letter so that we could get the dam reclassified, what is the status of that?
 Secretary Shake will follow up with the board and get it filed.
- Clarification on who our Liaison to the board now?

Treasurer's Report April 21, 2015

All data presented is as of March, 31 2015.

The Total Cash Balance is \$622,416.24 and is made up of the following fund balances:

General Fund - \$219,462.87 Lake Fund - \$75,428.82 Road Fund - \$64,408.30 Emergency Fund- \$62,466.13 Lake Fund CD - \$100,278.63 General Fund CD - \$100,371.49

The outstanding receivables total is \$92,348.39 a decrease of \$85,516.66. This includes \$69,854.91 of annual assessments which were due on March 1. A second notice including late fees has been sent. For additional breakdown, please refer to the attached Balance Sheet.

The Year-to-date Net Income is \$181,253.96 with Revenues of \$253,539.23 and Expenses of \$72,285.27. Please see the attach Profit and Loss Statement for further detail. Silt removal and clean-up was \$10,300. There were no unusual expenses in March.

As for actual Cash details, for the month of March the cash deposits were \$110,839.41 and the cash expenditures were \$24,659.90. Additional report details are posted on the Heritage Lake website.

The Finance committee met April 13, 2015. The progress of the Road Improvement Committee and SSA were discussed. The Finance committee will need more detail to prepare data for the SSA. Status of commitments to the engineering firm was also discussed. Currently three agreements totaling \$27,449 have been authorized. The process for finance committee review to provide guidance and eliminate financial risk was also discussed and affirmed. A method for streamlining the timesheet process for payroll will be investigated.
