- 1. Heritage Lake members only. A \$5.00 entry fee is required.
- 2. Double elimination format. If losing in the first round, player will drop down to the bottom bracket, and play the scheduled opponent. A second match loss results in the end of tournament play.
- 3. Best 2 out of 3 sets with tie-breaker at 6 6 in a set.
- 4. Draw will be made randomly and matches to be played will be posted on HLA website.
- 5. Each player must agree on time, and court location. It's suggested that the court at Heritage Lake be used, but it's not mandatory.
- 6. A no-show with a 20-minute grace period is considered a win for the player who is waiting. Emergency situations being the exception.
- 7. Email tournament director with match results.
- 8. Call tournament director (only) with problems, or concerns.
- 9. Sign up will be done by calling the Heritage Lake office, and leaving name, and contact phone #. Registrations will end on the end of business day 7/27/18.
- 10. Categories will be men's "Open."
- 11. Points will be made on the "honor system." If it's too close to call, the point will be replayed.
- 12. Each player is required to bring a brand new can of tennis balls to the match. The winner gets to keep the unopened can.

- 13. In case of an injury, or inability to continue play, the other player wins by default.
- 14. In a "rain out," both players can resume play at the earliest possible time and resume the match at the last scores.
- 15. Spectators, i.e., relatives, and friends are allowed to watch the match as long as they remain quiet during the serve, and the point being played. This is known as tennis etiquette. Children are allowed only if they can abide by this rule. Thank you!
