HERITAGE LAKE ASSOCIATION BACKYARD CHICKEN/FOWL ORDINANCE

At this time Heritage Lake Association Backyard Chicken/Fowl Ordinance is the same as the Tazewell County Ordinance with an addition of a Heritage Lake Backyard

Chicken/Fowl permit of \$25. Heritage Lake Association reserves the right to make their ordinance more stringent.

ARTICLE 25 SPECIAL USES

<u>7 TCC 1-25 (f) Requirements For Particular Special Uses.</u> In addition to the information required in 7 TCC 1-25 (c), the following contains information and requirements specific to each Special Use listed:

- (8) <u>CHICKENS/FOWL</u>. Specific requirements for chickens/fowl in the R-1 Low Density Residential District:
 - Chickens/Fowl shall only be permitted on a lot with a single-family residence which shall be inhabited on a full-time basis. Chickens/fowl shall be prohibited at duplex and multifamily buildings.
 - ii. Roosters shall be prohibited.
 - iii. The slaughtering of chickens/fowl shall not be allowed on-site, except for humane reasons.
 - iv. Chickens/fowl shall be kept for personal use only and shall be contained within a coop or enclosure / run at all times; No eggs or chickens/fowl shall be offered for sale on the premises.
 - v. The structure (coop) housing the chickens/fowl shall be located behind the rear plane of the existing dwelling (not in the front or side yard) and shall be maintained in a clean and sanitary condition at all times. Said coop shall be covered and ventilated to protect chickens/fowl from inclement weather and predators and shall provide a minimum of 4 square feet per chicken to allow for free movement. Said coop shall be located 10' from the side and rear yard property lines and electric service to the coops shall not be provided by an extension cord.

- vi. Chickens/fowl shall have access to a fenced enclosure / run providing a minimum of 10 square feet per chicken to allow for outdoor time, said fenced enclosure or run shall be 10' from any side or rear yard property lines. Chickens/fowl shall not be allowed to run freely on a lot. A 50-foot minimum lateral distance from the fenced enclosure to any well, in clay or loam soils, shall be maintained. For other soils the Tazewell County Health Department may be called on for assistance in determining a proper distance.
- vii Coops and fenced enclosures/runs shall be a minimum of 30' away from any existing structure on any adjoining parcel, such as dwellings, patios, porches, gazebos, decks, or swimming pools, but not including storage structures such as unattached garages or sheds.
- viii. Coops and fenced enclosures/runs shall be cleaned on a regular basis and remain free from undue accumulated waste, such as to cause odors reasonably detectable on adjacent properties.
- ix. All feed, except when placed for consumption by chickens/fowl, shall be kept in containers with tightly fitted lids that are rodent-proof.
- x. The number of chickens/fowls shall be allowed on the following minimum lot sizes:
 - 10,000 square feet to 2 acres = 6 chickens
 - 2.01 acres to 5 acres = 8
 - 5.01 acres to 9.99 acres = 10
- xx. PLEASE NOTE: Tazewell County requires an additional Building Permit for ANY structure over 25 sq. ft. This would include a chicken coop.

ARTICLE 33

FEE SCHEDULE
